HOW TO PLAY **Dicey 21**

Dicey 21 combines variations of Blackjack and Chuck-a-Luck into a single game.

- ◆ The **21** game is like regular blackjack except:
 - 1- you play against a payable instead of the dealer;
 - 2- you get one initial card instead of two;
 - 3- your final hit is a roll of two community dice; and
 - 4- basic strategy is painlessly quick & easy to master!
- ◆ **Chuck-a-Luck PLUS** is a simple number matching game that uses three community dice plus one player card. The object is to match a number bet with one or more of the three community dice.

Playing 21 (Dicey Blackjack)

Start by placing your ante on the betting spot labeled "1." The dealer then gives each player one card face up. After seeing your card, you have the option to raise one or two times your ante (double or triple) by placing your wager on the betting spot labeled "2." Then, at your turn, indicate whether you wish to stand or draw additional cards. After all players have received their cards, the dealer shakes the dice cup and removes its cover to reveal the dice. Your final score is the total of your card(s) added to the total of the two dice that match in color. (The off-color die is not used in the '21' game.)

Playing Chuck-a-Luck Plus

You may make one to three wagers on the field of six betting spots representing all the sides of a single die. Multiple wagers may be of equal or unequal amounts. For each wager, you win if any of the three community dice match your bet. The payouts range from 1 to 1 for a single dice match to 40 to 1 for a triple dice match with a matching card.

Chuck-a-Luck PLUS

For Each Number Bet Dice ONLY Matches Pay

Double	2 to 1

Quad	40 to 1
Royal	20 to 1
Quad is Triple plus matching Card	
Royal is Triple plus King or Queen PLUS Match with 1 st card only	

A blackjack is a score of '21' made with just one card. The blackjack possibilities are:

- ◆ Draw an Ace and roll 10
- ◆ Draw a 10, J, Q or K and roll 11
- ◆ Draw a 9 and roll 12

Chuck-a-Luck PLUS: For the dice ONLY matches, a Triple occurs when a bet matches all three dice; a Triple PLUS match occurs when a triple dice match occurs and the player's first card is either a royal (K or Q) or the same rank as the dice.

Basic Strategy

RAISE? You have an advantage and should always raise when you draw a first card Ace, 2, or 3. You have even odds and can play your hunch when you are dealt a ten card (T, J, Q or K).

STAND or HIT? Always hit on hard card totals 8 and lower and on soft totals 15, 16, 17, and 18. Stand on all other totals. (Soft totals are hands that contain an Ace that can be counted as 11 or 1.)
